Sean Fitzpatrick is Director of the Department of Development Services for the City of Hartford, appointed by Mayor Luke Bronin in January 2016. Mr. Fitzpatrick previously served as Chief of Staff to the Chairman of the Port Authority of New York & New Jersey, John Degnan, who was appointed to lead reform efforts at the agency in the wake of the 2013 “Bridgagate” scandal. Before entering government service in 2014, Mr. Fitzpatrick spent two decades in the insurance industry, helping to establish one of Metro Hartford’s most successful insurance start-ups, Executive Risk Inc., in the 1990s and later holding senior executive positions with Chubb and The Hartford. Mr. Fitzpatrick has served as a board member of the Hartford Symphony Orchestra and as an adjunct professor at the University of Connecticut School of Law. He is a former chairman of the Town of Simsbury’s Economic Development Commission and was named “Business Leader of the Year” by the Simsbury Chamber of Commerce in 2000. Mr. Fitzpatrick is a graduate of Amherst College and Harvard Law School.
